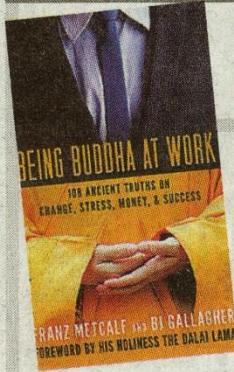

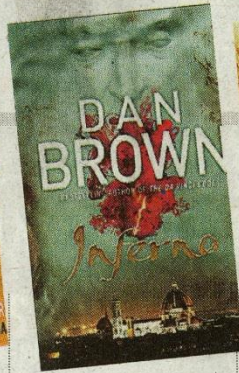
Five new books that caught our eye

By Franz Metcalf and BJ Gallagher

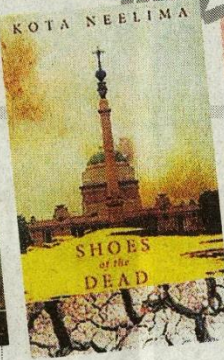
This book shows how to embody the Buddha mind — a source of calm compassion and insight — in the stress and clamor of the workplace.

By Kota Neelima

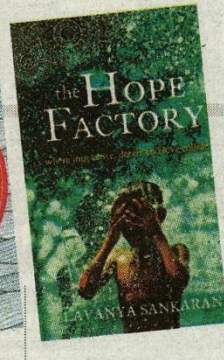
